Procedural Notes

- Approval to do a Master Thesis can be granted upon the successful completion of 60 ECTS credits in examinations from completed modules (§ 13 (4) FPO).
- The Masters`Thesis will by supervised by university lectures and private lectures of Kiel University, who generally offer modules in the International Master of Applied Ecology degree programme. In exceptional cases and with the consent of the Examination Board for the International Master of Applied Ecology degree programme at Kiel University, the Master's Thesis may be prepared at an institution outside the University, provides that appropriate supervision of the candidate is available there. Supervision may also be provides by people working at the supervising facility, who are qualified in accordance with Article 5, Subparagraph 2 of the Examination Procedural Regulations (Prüfungsverfahrensordnung PVO). The Examination Board for the International Master of Applied Ecology degree programme at Kiel University will determine whether the requirements have been met. In accordance with Section 5 of the Examination Procedure Regulations (PVO), the second supervisor must be an authorised examiner.
- Submit the application form in person during the Examination Office's opening hours. The first page must be filled in completely and be signed by both reviewers.
- The signature of the first examiner is valid for three weeks, after which time a registration with this application form is no longer possible.
